Tenure Track Professor of Pastoral Studies

The School of Theology and Religious Studies at The Catholic University of America invites applications for a full-time faculty position in pastoral studies to begin Fall 2018. The successful applicant will preferably possess a STD, also acceptable are PhD or D. Min with a specialization in pastoral studies or some related theological discipline and be a practicing Catholic in good standing with the Church. Candidates with a PhD and STD are eligible for a tenure-track position.

The successful candidate will be expected to teach courses at the undergraduate and graduate level in pastoral theology and ministry, advise students, and serve on committees of the school and university. Directing theses, doctoral dissertations, and D.Min project treatises will be expected contingent upon the applicant's terminal degree. Rank and salary will be determined on the basis of academic credentials and publication record.
